On February 8, 2024 Capt. [REDACTED] and myself (Capt. [REDACTED] were in the investigation room at OSCI. We were inventorying/inspecting the donations that came into OSCI. While going through one on the boxes of donated books from Wisconsin Books To Prisoners 1202 Williamson St., #1 Madison, WI 53703, one of the bundles of books tested positive for Cocaine on the IONSCAN 600. This bundle was addressed to [REDACTED] at OSCI. At this point Capt. [REDACTED] and myself put all of the bundles of books back into the original box they were received in due to the positive test. This box of donated books wasn't given to the intended recipients due to positive drug test. Written for documentation.All books contained within the box of the contaminated books, were denied.This decision was based on fact of the contaminated books, combined with knowledge that there are not reliable test kits for some substances (such as K2). As such other books could be contaminated.Attempting to keep illicit drugs and intoxicating substances (K2, suboxone, wasp spray) out of the institution is a priority due to the extreme risk they pose and the extreme difficulty in identification and interception.
